Section A: Any size container

(one entry only per exhibitor in Classes A1 and A2)

- Class A1 3 pots of cyclamen shown for flower
- Class A2 3 pots of cyclamen shown for foliage
- Class A3 *C. coum* shown for flower
- Class A4 *C. coum* shown for foliage
- Class A5 *C. persicum* florists cultivar shown for flower
- Class A6 *C. elegans* shown for flower
- Class A7 *C. alpinum* shown for flower
- Class A8 *C. parviflorum* shown for flower
- Class A9 *C. libanoticum* shown for flower
- Class A10 Any inter-specific hybrid shown for flower or foliage or both
- Class A11 Any cyclamen species not eligible for Classes A3 to A10 shown flower
- Class A12 Any Autumn-flowering species shown for foliage
- Class A13 Any cyclamen species except *C. coum* shown for foliage
- Class A14 Any cyclamen collected on a Cyclamen Society Field Study, shown for flower or foliage or both
- Class A15 Any cyclamen raised from seed by the exhibitor, shown for flower or foliage or both. State date of sowing. Informative notes welcome

Section B: Pot size external diameter 19 cm maximum

- Class B1 *C. coum* shown for flower
- Class B2 *C. coum* shown for foliage
- Class B3 *C. alpinum* shown for flower
- Class B4 Any cyclamen species not eligible for Classes B1 to B3 shown for flower
- Class B5 Any cyclamen species except *C. coum* shown for foliage

Section C: Novice Section, any size container

- Class C1 *C. coum* shown for flower
- Class C2 *C. alpinum* shown for flower
- Class C3 Any cyclamen species not eligible for Classes C1 or C2 shown for flower
- Class C4 Any cyclamen species shown for foliage

Section D: Non-competitive Section, any size container

- Class D1 Any cyclamen species or display of plants or seedlings, unusual or of interest to other members and visitors, or plants not wished to be entered in competitive classes
- Class D2 Any associated plants that grow with cyclamen or in close proximity to wild populations

Section E: Photographic Section

- Class E1 One colour photograph of cyclamen in the wild
- Class E2 One colour photograph of cyclamen in cultivation
- Class E3 One colour photograph of any companion plant in the wild (non-competitive)
- Class E4 One colour photograph of any companion plant in cultivation (non-competitive)
